The Past



When I came to Beaverton High School in the summer of 2010, I knew straight away that it was a special place. Over time, I came to know deeply, personally, and profoundly all the extraordinary attributes that are representative of our beloved BHS. But I also felt that there was a need to renew and refresh our culture to truly embody the history, community, and passion of Beaverton High School.

In my second year, we crafted our core values: **Excellence Inspires Us, Learning Transforms Us, Community Connects Us, and Tradition Unites Us** to reflect the unique and exceptional characteristics of BHS. These values still guide our work every day. We also crafted our school mission, which still serves as the North Star of our endeavors: **We believe that all students should graduate from BHS prepared for, confident in, and excited about the futures they choose.**

The Present



Over the last few years, BHSSF played an integral part in helping shape and enhance the culture at BHS, with our Board of Directors helping us identify ways to improve the student and staff experience. I can't begin to articulate what it means for a high school principal to have the financial resources and backing available through the Beaverton High School Success Fund. That support enabled us to:

- Increase student involvement by underwriting fees, including those for ASB stickers, classes, athletic participation, AP exams, and other activities.
- Underwrite free yearbooks for all graduating seniors and a portion of their cap/gown/announcement packages.
- Award \$150,000 in college scholarships for graduates of the 2022 school year, a portion of which awarded students who exemplified our core values.
- Provide funding for teachers to offer immersive learning experiences.
- Underwrite the after-school weight room and student wellness rooms.
- Foster a greater sense of community by remodeling common areas and gathering places.

The Future



After 10 years of service as BHS principal, in March, I announced my retirement. Serving this community was the greatest honor of my career as an educator. As I look back on the past decade, there are memories of victories and accomplishments celebrated; difficulties overcome, innovative and transformative changes made, and so much joy.

With the continued support of our generous donors, the Beaverton High School Success Fund will be able to build upon this strong foundation to not only continue the current programs but to keep finding new ways to strengthen our community and enhance the student and staff experience for years to come.

I have loved every day of my time at BHS, and I am profoundly grateful to the people who supported me along our journey together—**Community Connects Us**.

We often say, "Once a Beaver, always a Beaver." I remain committed to BHS and look forward, with you, to the amazing future ahead.

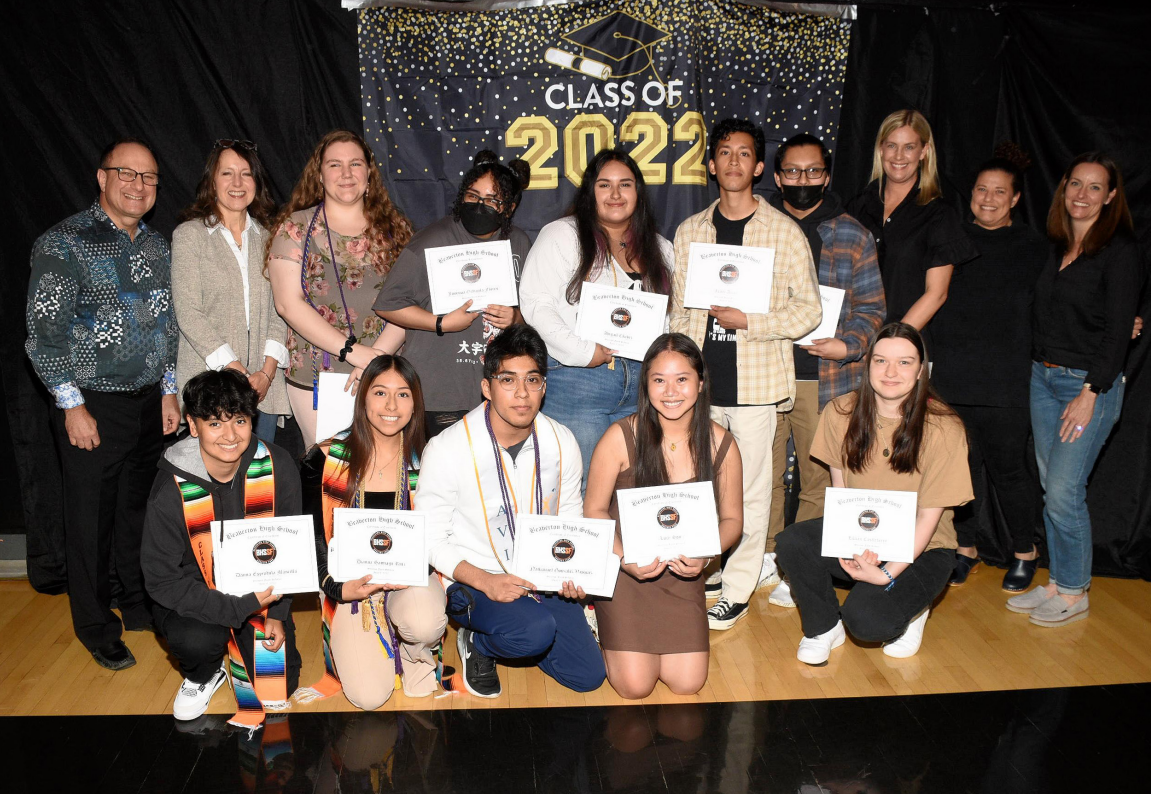

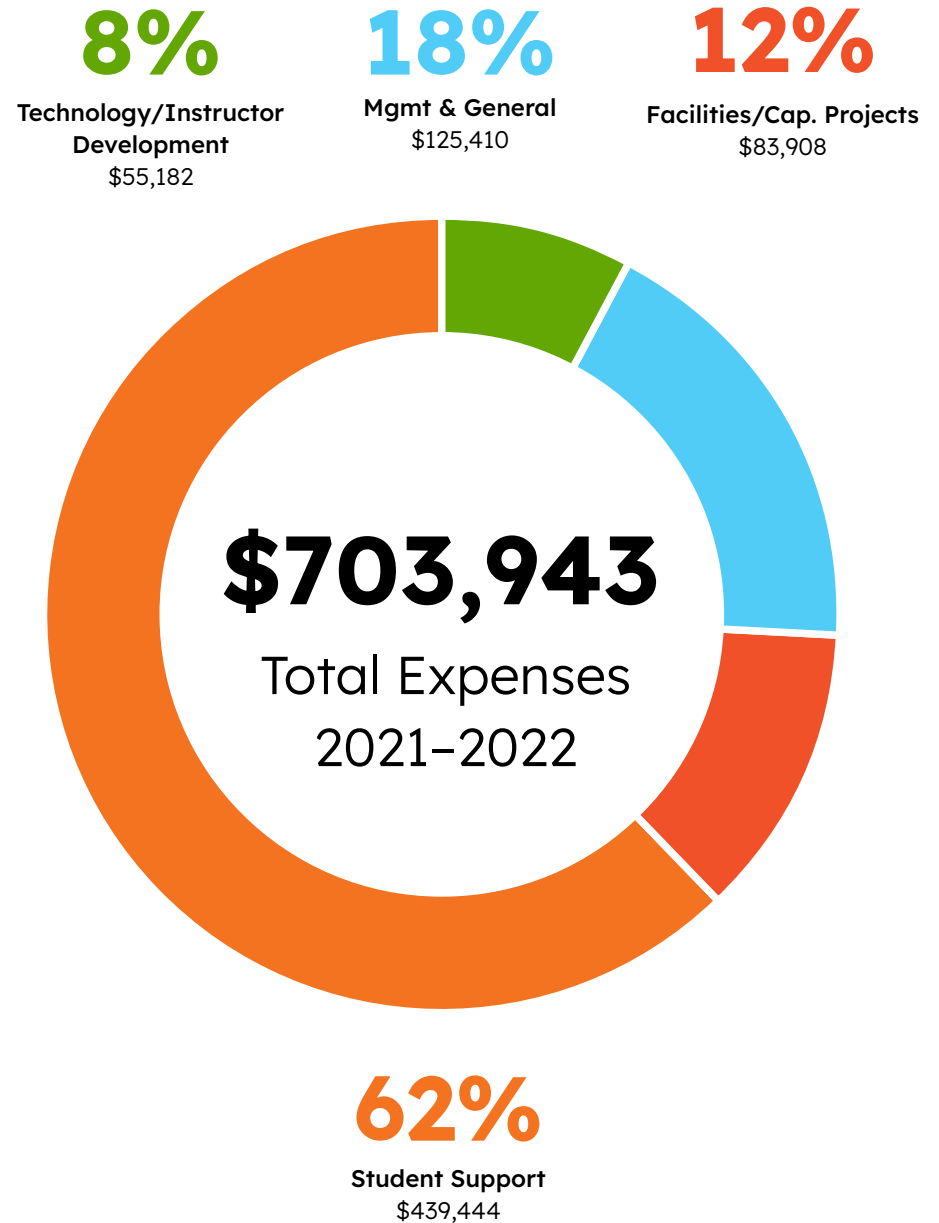
